<p>Program background</p>	<p>Rotary International has long been a supporter of foreign study as a way to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Build international understanding ▪ Increase awareness of and respect for cultural differences ▪ Encourage people to dedicate their personal and professional lives to improving the quality of life for people across the world. <p>Rotary Global Grant Scholarships are now administered by individual Rotary Districts, and are awarded to college graduates with a background, intended graduate studies, and future career plans related to one or more of these focus areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution ▪ Disease Prevention and Treatment ▪ Water and Sanitation ▪ Maternal and Child Health ▪ Basic Education and Literacy ▪ Economic and Community Development
<p>The scholarship</p>	<p>The Rotary Global Grant Scholarship is a \$30,000 award for graduate study in a geographic area that has a Rotary presence. The winner must plan to enroll in a graduate-level program that starts no earlier than beginning of the academic year in the fall of 2016 and concludes no later than December 30, 2017, and expend the scholarship funds within 12 months of starting studies.</p>

Eligibility	<p>Applicants must currently work, live, or study in Rotary District 6220 (see map on reverse side). Because the southern District boundary in the Appleton area is the Outagamie and Winnebago/Calumet County line, applicants must either work, live, or study north of Calumet Street.</p> <p>Rotarians, or children or grandchildren of Rotarians are <u>not</u> eligible.</p>
The process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete and submit the Prequalification Application directly to the District by February 29, 2016. 2. The District Scholarship Committee will review these by March 21 and finalists will be notified on March 22. 3. Finalists must then send a Complete Application and accompanying documents (personal letter of introduction, academic transcripts, and two reference letters) to the District by April 30. 4. Applicants selected will be interviewed in person on May 14, 2016 in Stevens Point. The winner will be notified on May 15.
