The free clinic was founded in 1997 as Fox Cities Community Health Center and has grown into a full service medical provider for patients living in Outagamie, Winnebago, and Calumet counties in Central Wisconsin. Partnership Community Health Center collaborates with community partners to create a medical home for patients. They provide consistent, compassionate, high quality services to build and sustain a healthy community. Some of the services they provide are: Adult Health, Behavioral Health, Children's Health, Dental, Health Insurance Enrollment, Homeless Care, Immigration Assistance, Prescription Assistance and Women's Health. The PCHC has gone through vigorous training to make sure they serve a diverse culture and they do what it takes for people to get the right plan for them and know how to use their plan.
