THE STATUS OF WOMEN IN NE WISCONSIN REPORT – BECKY BOULANGER

The Women’s Fund for the fox valley region, inc. invests in women and girls through: grants, advocacy and education. They currently have 2.3 million in assets, 58 named funds, 80 nonprofit supported, 204 programs funded and awarded \$1.2 million in grants. The Women’s Funds first released the Status of Women in Northeast Wisconsin Report in 2011. Usind data compiled in partnership with the Wisconsin Women’s Council for Brown, Fond du Lac, Outagamie and Winnebago counties, as well as the state of Wisconsin. The 2017 report gives a current and comprehensive picture of the most pressuring issues for women and girls in Northeast Wisconsin. Key Findings from the report include: poverty rates are higher for women than men; across all age groups and older woen are twice as lucky as older men to be in poverty. Regionally, the wage gap ranges from 72 cents on the dollar an average for women in Fond du Lac county to 78 cents in Brown county. One out of five women in the region has some college expereince, but has not completed a degree. The teen birth rate in Northeast Wisconsin continues a steady decline, follwing the statewide trend. Women in our region have fewer poor physical or mental health days than in the past. The report is produced as a series of fat sheets that analyze data related to 12 key indicators of the status of women in our region: Benefit Program Enrollment, Corporate Leadership, Educational Attainment, Free & Reduced-Price School Meals, Health & Well-Being, Political Representation, Violence Against Women, Who is in Poverty, Women & Povety, Women in Population, Women, Work and Wages, Weomen’s Business Ownership. The report confirms that depsite our many successes, much work needs to be done to help women and girls reach their full potential.
