The Memory Café is designed for those with early stage dementia, mild memory loss or cognitive impairment and family and friends of those affected. The Memory Café's offer opportunities for socialization to persons with memory loss and their family care partners and friends. They consist of informal conversations, a program (ie. speaker, music, arts, games), and refreshments. Research shows that Memory Café participation reduces social isolation, provides enjoyable interaction without stigma, acts as an entry point for needed resources and offers access to information. Local research has identified social isolation as a major challenge for people living with dementia and for their care takers.
