Profits from each appointment are used to fund auto repairs for domestic violence survivors. It started in 2014, when two domestic violence agencies came together to discuss a recurring problem. Too many domestic abuse victims were unable to leave an abusive relationship because they didn't have the safe, reliable transportation they needed to get employment or education and become self-sufficient. The garage is different to other garages because: 1. They give the purple carpet treatment – Purple is the color of courage and creativity, and is the symbol of support for survivors of domestic abuse. You can expect a warm personal experience, honest answers about your vehicle and the knowledge you are making a difference. 2. Sparking Change – profits from their work help keep domestic abuse survivors on the road to self-sufficiency. Their educational workshops will help women feel more comfortable and confident about vehicle ownership. 3. Bringing more Women into Auto Repair Careers – Fewer than 10% of all auto repair technicians are women. JumpStart will help change that by introducing more women to these well-paying, family-supporting careers.
