KAUKAUNA LIBRARY PROJECT

The historic Eagle Mill was built by John Stoveken and his half-brother, Colonel H.A. Frambach in 1872 as a flour mill. The mill changed hands several times over the years until it was purchased by Oscar Thilmany in 1945. The historic Mill sits on the edge of Downtown Kaukauna overlooking the scenic Fox River across from the popular 1000 Islands Nature Preserve. The building itself is a rare example of the 19th century utilitarian-style mill, with many architectural features and character-defining elements that maintain its historical integrity. Cobbled limestone façade, ornamental climbing vines, arched windows, interior brick walls, exposed timber columns, ceiling joints and large, open spaces are just a few of the features that describe its charm. Stadtmuller & Associates has been working with community leaders since 2012 to preserve and repurpose the 82,000 square-foot historic Eagle Mill in Kaukauna. The renovation was completed in early 2016. The first floor of the building houses the Kaukauna Public Library, and the lower river level includes office/retail space for lease. The entire second floor of the renovated mill is leased to Expera Specialty Solutions for their new headquarters. As the new home of the Kaukauna Public Library, this renovated mill welcomes more than 150,000 visitors per year. This historic preservation project was made possible by these public-private partners.
