**Today** there were 32 participants at today's meeting, our first-ever Zoom Conference! Tony Gonzalez presented on behalf of The United Way Fox Cities and Community Foundation.

These two organizations in the Fox Valley Region leveraged their long-standing relationship to create the Community Response Fund. It started with each donating \$50k and as of today has a balance of \$770k. They meet twice a week to get the money back into the community as quickly as possible.

They are doing in-depth meetings with nonprofits and are learning about the basic needs challenges many in our community are facing. This is a time of rapid change from one week to the next, and they will continue to stay on top of what those evolving needs are.
